# SYMPTOM:

High heat may be observed at the charger to extension cord plug interface

### ISSUE:

High resistance at the charger to cord interface

WARNING: ALWAYS USE THE WALL PLUG TO CONNECT AND DISCONNECT POWER TO THE CHARGER (FIG A)

PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY MAY RESULT IF THE OPERATOR OF THE MACHINE USES THE CHARGER TO EXTENSION CORD CONNECTION POINT AS A LOCATION TO CONNECT AND DISCONNECT THE ONBOARD CHARGER POWER. (FIG B) INSPECT THE CORD FOR SIGNS OF DAMAGE (IE PITTING, DISCOLORATION, DEGRADATION) AS SHOWN IN FIG C INDICATED BY THE RED ARROW BELOW.



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# CAUSE:

- 1) Water ingress or contamination at the charger and extension cord interconnect plug
- 2) Using the charger and extension cord interconnect point as the primary disconnect point when plugging in and unplugging the charger during normal use

- Improved orientation of the plug assembly
- A new method for securing the connection point by installing bolt down P clamps on both sides of interconnect cord



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
# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

# ▲ WARNING!

DISCONNECT BATTERIES BEFORE SERVICING.

- REMOVE MOUNTING TABS AND CABLE TIES
- 1 SEE FIGURE 1. Cut Cable Ties (A & B).
- 2 Remove Screws (C) and save for reuse.
- 3 Discard Mounting Tabs (D).
- 4 Cut the plug off the end of the battery charger cord attached to the battery charger.
- 5 Discard the old power cord that plugged into the battery charger.


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INSTALL NEW CHARGER CORD PLUG

- 6 SEE FIGURE 2. Strip the end of the Charger Cord (E) as shown.
- 7 Disassemble Plug (6) and install on Charger Cord (E) as shown.



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#### INSTALL POWER CORD BRACKET AND POWER CORDS

- 8 SEE FIGURE 3. Install Power Cord Bracket (3) as shown using Screws (C) removed in FIGURE 1 and Hose Support Clamps (2). NOTE: Bracket (3) mounts to the same holes as the Mounting Tabs (D) removed in FIGURE 1
- 9 Mount Charger Cord (E) to Bracket (3) as shown using Screw (1) and Hose Support Clamp (2).
- 10 Plug Charge Cord (5) into Plug (6) and then secure to Bracket (3) using the remaining Hose Support Clamp (2) and Screw (1). NOTE: Kit 56383394 includes two Cords (5). Use the appropriate cord depending on your needs.
- 11 Use the two Cable Ties (4) to replace the Cable Ties (A & B) cut off in FIGURE 1.
- 12 Reconnect the batteries and wrap Cord (5) around the cord wrap on the rear of the machine.
