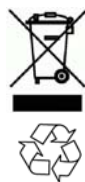
Installation instructions for **kit number 9006895**

SYNOPSIS:

This kit contains the parts needed to replace the engine flywheel starter plate on the following machines: **6600, 6650, 8200, 8210, 7400, M20** serial numbers 000000-003122, **M30** serial numbers 000000-001320, **T20** serial numbers 000000-002140, **S30** serial numbers 000000-001970. Please follow step-by-step instructions.

PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT

PREPARATION:

1. Park the machine on a clean level surface, turn off the machine, remove the key, and set the parking brake.

FOR SAFETY: Before leaving or servicing machine, stop on level surface, turn off machine, and remove key.

2. Open the engine compartment and remove the old starter ring.

INSTALLATION:

When replacing the flywheel starter ring, be sure to install the spacer to maintain the correct distance between the flywheel and the engine. (Fig. 1)

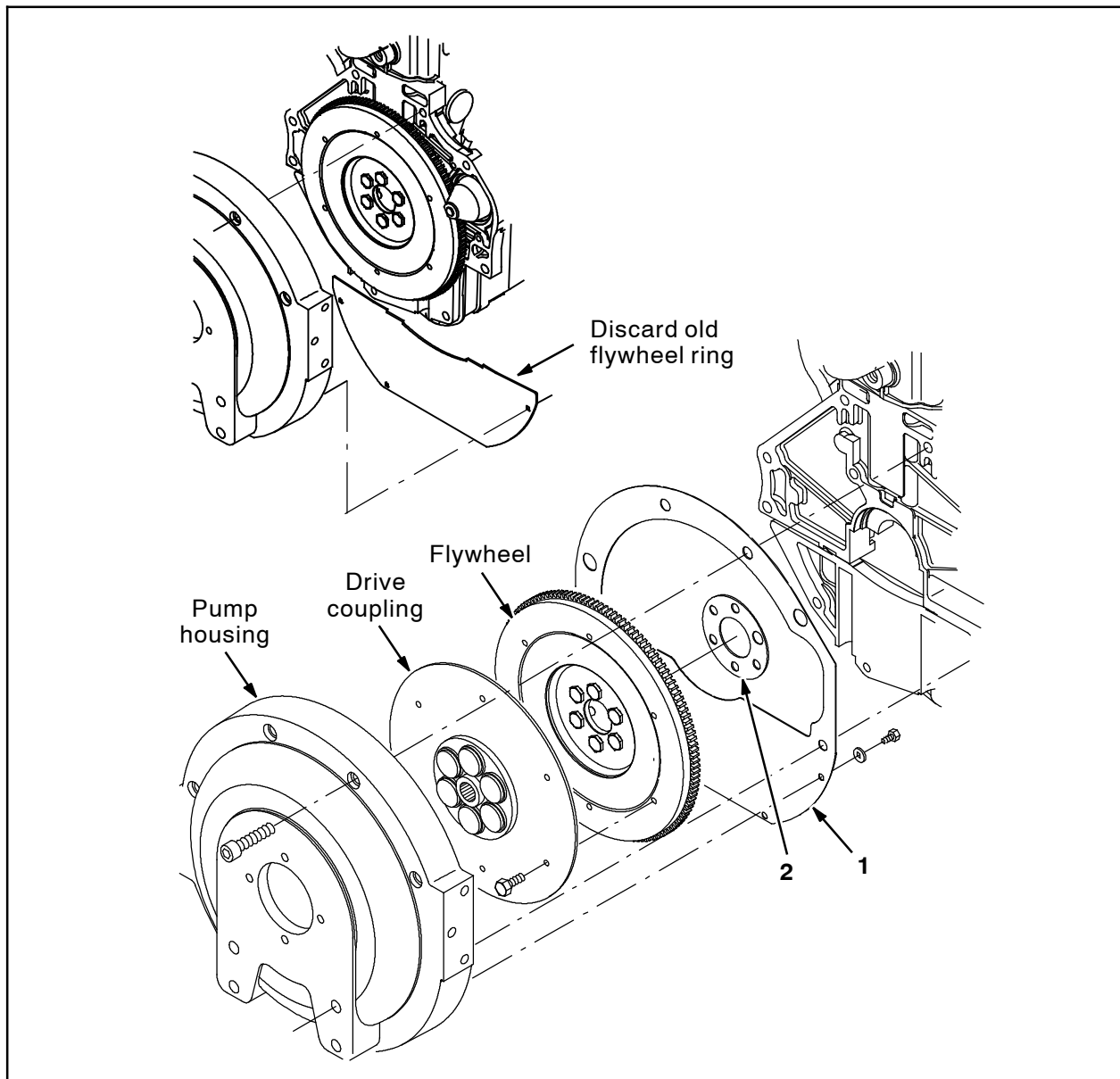
